**Dersin İçeriği:** This course is an introduction to the field of conflict analysis and resolution. The main aim is to introduce students to academic thinking about conflict analysis and resolution and to help them to think systematically and analytically about conflict and its resolution. This course will consist of a mix of lectures, group dialogues and case studies. Understanding how and why conflict emerges and how it may be addressed will be the main questions to be discussed. The module will also provide the student with an understanding of the way that different actors operate at different levels of analysis. Students will acquire an understanding of the skills require to intervene, manage and resolve international and internal conflicts.
